Trusted Platform Module

The Trusted Platform Module (TPM) is a chip in your Commission laptop. To use it, authenticate with your biometrics or Windows PIN. Your laptop must be in WELCOME.



EU Login app

This is a free mobile application you can download to your smartphone.

Step 1

Search for the EU Login app in the Google Play Store (Android) or the App Store (iOS) and download it.

Step 2

Open the app, tap on **Initialise** and accept the 'Allow notifications' request. Follow the instructions on the screen.



Security key

This is a plug-in device, available on approval from your DG's procurement team or privately.
